Following up on your March 2016 authorization, attached is a proposal to provide landscaping design of improvements for General Courtney Hodges Boulevard. Carter & Sloope was selected based on its experience and being certified by GDOT for landscaping design. The \$20,000 cost would be paid from the SPLOST 12 Construction Fund. The Administration recommends Council approve the proposal.

Dear Mr. Gilmour:

Thank you for the opportunity to offer this proposal for landscaping improvements along General Courtney Hodges Boulevard. Based on our meeting in your office, the field visit with Mr. Deal shortly thereafter, and our research over the past weeks, we feel comfortable that we understand the project and what is required to ensure its successful design and delivery. As you know, Carter & Sloop carries certification by GDOT to design landscape improvements in GDOT ROW and are accustomed to coordinating and permitting similar projects in this area.

We understand that the City of Perry would like the Courtney Hodges Corridor to be improved aesthetically to create a dramatic entranceway into the City's downtown area and would like the proposed enhancements to compliment beautification efforts currently in place throughout the City.

The following bullet points provide a brief summary of our proposed approach and understanding of the tasking for this project:

1. Provide a Concept Plan for landscaping and corridor improvements along General Courtney Hodges Boulevard from Commerce Street to Kellwood Drive.
  - a. Median Landscaping with Irrigation as needed.
  - b. Potential modifications of curb and gutter and sidewalks to enhance streetscape aesthetics.
  - c. Preserve existing street lighting to extent practical.
2. Coordinate with GDOT to verify approvability of concept plan prior to presentation to the City
3. Provide a color rendering reflecting a driver's perspective (or similar) along the future corridor

4. Provide a cost estimate for the proposed enhancements including a block by block breakdown (or similar) for future phasing and budgeting
5. Attend a Meeting/Presentation with City Officials to discuss/present the Concept Plan, Rendering, and Cost Estimate

We are very excited about the opportunity to serve the City of Perry on this project. We propose to complete the above scope of work for the lump sum total of \$20,000 and can deliver the above in approximately 3 months from notice to proceed.

We can provide a more formal agreement form if you choose to proceed with the work and please don't hesitate to contact us with any comments or questions or with any requested expansion or contraction to the defined scope that could affect price.
