Thank you for the opportunity to offer this proposal for landscaping improvements along General Courtney Hodges Boulevard. Based on our meeting in your office, the field visit with Mr. Deal shortly thereafter, and our research over the past weeks, we feel comfortable that we understand the project and what is required to ensure its successful design and delivery. As you know, Carter & Sloope carries certification by GDOT to design landscape improvements in GDOT ROW and are accustomed to coordinating and permitting similar projects in this area.
