There is a significant problem with solid waste collection in the downtown district. A series of options have been attempted but no overall strategies have been developed. The popularity of the district will compound the problem.




Solid waste collection site #2

As discussed in my July 24, 2019 memo, the downtown district has a solid waste collection issue.

Another example is where to locate the solid waste dumpster for Oliver Hazzard's restaurant. The Administration recommends Council approve purchasing the parcel owned by the Downtown Development Authority of the City of Perry facing Commerce Street and turn it into a landscaped collection site. This would greatly assist the downtown, open up the Carroll Street alley for better flow of traffic and avoid having to pay \$150,000 plus to relocate a major utility pole.



REFERENCE: Houston Lake Road impact

With the widening of Houston Lake Road between Kings Chapel Road and Gray Road, the Georgia Department of Transportation is requiring a right hand turn lane onto Kings Chapel Road at the intersection. Best management practices require Griggs Street be closed at its intersection with Houston Lake Road for safety purposes.

The Administration recommends Council approve blocking Griggs Street at Kings Chapel Road when construction begins and advise the Houston County Board of Commissioners immediately. A site map is attached.
