

A PROPOSAL

PLACE A LIFE-SIZE METAL SCULPTURE OF A DEER
AT
ROTARY PARK

THE SCULPTURE

The proposed sculpture is to be made in the fashion of the Metal Horse Sculpture that is located on the grounds of the Perry Events Center. The artist Donnie Wright of Cochran, who created the horse, has agreed to create a life-sized buck deer for Rotary Park. The artist will also install the sculpture.

LOCATION

It is expected that Council will appoint Council Member/s to choose a site within the park that will be easily visible, both to drive-by traffic and to walk-up viewing. It is recommended that those appointees will conduct an on-site consultation with the artist in order to choose the optimum site.

FUNDING

Houston Arts Alliance, together with an anonymous donor, will underwrite the creation and installation of the sculpture.

COMPLETION DATE

Should City Council approve the proposal, it is expected that the artist will complete and install it by late fall, 2022.

REFERENCE: Replacement of Police Chief

With the resignation of Chief Lynn, the council needs to determine the process it would like to follow for his replacement and how to proceed in the interim.

First, for the selection of Chief Lynn's replacement the Administration offers two (2) options:

- City receive all applications, its Personnel Committee selects the top 5 or 7, and forwards the top candidates to the Georgia Association of Chiefs of Police for assessment.
- City forwards all applicants to the Georgia Association of Chiefs of Police for assessment and it forwards the best 5 for council consideration.

Second, the Administration recommends Captain A. Everidge be designated intern Police Chief and given a 10% base pay increase for the intern period.
