Fire Safety Poster Contest Rules**

**Eligibility:**

All third-grade students in City of Perry public and private schools and homeschooled third-graders are eligible.

**Poster requirements:**

Posters created by students must be their own original artwork. Copyrighted characters (such as Mickey Mouse) or copyrighted clipart will not be accepted.

**Materials:**

Posters must be done on paper. Poster board will not be accepted. Students may use a variety of media: such as watercolor, pen and ink, crayon, markers, etc. Light pencil marks and chalk will not show up on copies. Keep in mind that the posters of the winner and runner-up will be on display, so they should be easy to see and read.

**Size and layout:**

Minimum poster sizes: 8 1/2" x 11"

Maximum poster sizes: 18" x 24"

Posters may be landscape or portrait layout

**Release form:**

Each poster must have the release form securely fastened to the back of the poster. The release form can be found either attached to the contest rules or on the City of Perry website at [perry-ga.gov](http://perry-ga.gov).

***A poster not accompanied by a completed release form will not be eligible for judging.***

**Judging procedure:**

All posters with releases affixed to the back that are received by October 31 will be reviewed by a panel of five (5) judges at City of Perry Fire Department Headquarters. The posters will be judged based on the following criteria:

- Clear message conveyed by the text and artwork
- Use of assigned theme
- Creativity, originality, and artistic quality
- Visual clarity – easy to see and read

**Awards**

A winner and a runner-up will be awarded based on the creativity for the theme.

The winner and runner-up will receive a "Certificate of Achievement" from the City of Perry Fire Chief and the honor of having their artwork displayed in City of Perry buildings.

The winner will be offered a pizza party for their class with City of Perry firefighters and a ride to or from school in a fire truck with covid-19 precautions in place.

Winners will be notified by December 1, 2022 by email or telephone.

**Please Remember**

Entries must meet the requirements specified above and must have the release form securely fastened to the back of the poster. Entries not accompanied by a completed release will not be eligible for judging. All artwork submitted becomes property of the City of Perry Fire Department and may be reproduced. All entries must be received by **October 31, 2022.**
