Cat Trapping in the City of Perry

There are two main ways residents of the City of Perry can trap nuisance cats.

The first is borrowing a trap from the Perry Animal Control when available. Please call ahead to ensure availability.

The second is acquiring one's own humane trap (Ace, Tractor Supply, Amazon, ect.). Private traps must be clearly marked with contact information. The city is not liable for the return or condition of private traps.

Residents must call the PAC ahead to ensure there is available space for animals. Residents must not set traps on holidays, over weekends or in extreme weather conditions. Residents must check the traps regularly and notify PAC if there is a cat for pickup. Due to current veterinary coverage, trapped cats are only accepted on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Pickup hours are 8:30 am to 4:00 pm on regular business days. Collected animals will be assessed and handled per city policy and city code.

The PAC only traps domestic dogs and cats. Wildlife concerns must be addressed by a private contractor or the Department of Natural Resources.
