Help Prevent pollution!

- Never dump anything directly into a storm drain
- Never throw anything down a storm drain
- Dumping into a storm drain is wrong. IT IS ILLEGAL.
- Keep hazardous fluids away from the streets and storm drains.
- Spills (chemical) are required by law to be reported (911) or Stormwater Division: 478-988-2735.
