Spring Rains and Stormwater Drains

City of Perry's catch basins, or storm drains, on the side of the road funnel rainwater to the various creeks throughout the city.

Spring is right around the corner and lawn preparation underway, now is a good time to look at your yard's watering system. You may not think of your hose and gutters as a "system" but they both can help direct water where you want it most, on your lawn and plants verse down the storm drains.

Instead of directing your gutter downspouts into your driveway or street, direct the rainwater collected by your roof to water your lawn or garden. Help your yard soak up free water, while keeping dirty rainwater out of the local creeks.

With spring showers coming, it is important to remember that pollutants and debris washed into these storm drains. Help protect the local waterways, **ONLY RAIN DOWN THE DRAINS.**
