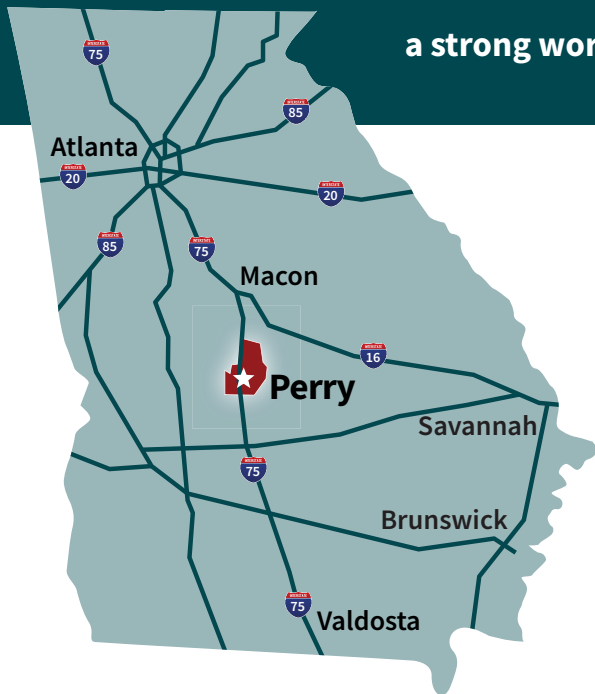

Workforce Development and Education

The city of Perry is located in Houston County, Georgia. In 2020, the Houston County School District took first place on Forbes list of Best Employers in Georgia. The district consists of 39 campuses, a career academy, and serves approximately 30,000 students. Perry is within close proximity to nine colleges and universities and a technical college producing a highly trained skilled workforce for area employers. Customized training for companies is available through Central Georgia Technical College.
