### **“Scope of Services”**

The City of Perry is seeking a qualified contractor to supply quotes for the replacement of approximately 140 linear foot of suppression panels at the department’s shooting range located at 261 Toomer Road, Perry, GA 31069. Quotes should include all labor and material cost for the following requirements:

1. Cut off existing 6”x6” posts (used for existing panels) at ground level.
2. Install twelve new 6”x6” supports to a height of 11’5”, set on cap block. Supports to be installed in two rows of six.
3. Install seven rows of 2”x10”s on the 6”x6” supports and one 2”x10” flat center brace on the rear of each panel
4. Pour concrete to grade in each of the twelve support holes
5. Clean up/haul off of current panels and all debris from new construction



### **“Insurance Requirements”**

- CLIENT will require the CONTRACTOR to provide evidence of appropriate professional liability insurance and workers’ compensation insurance coverage prior to commencement of work
- Such coverage must be provided by an insurance company or companies authorized to do business in the State of Georgia with at least an “A” rating by A.M. Best.
- Certificates of Insurance must name the CLIENT as an Additional Insured, shall provide that the CONTRACTOR’S policy is primary and not non-contributory over any insurance carried by the CLIENT, waives subrogation and shall provide that the policy will not be cancelled or materially changed without 30 days prior notice in writing to the CLIENT.
- Minimum insurance coverages required of the CONTRACTOR are as follows: General Liability of \$1,000,000.00, Vehicle Liability of \$1,000,000.00 Workers’ Compensation at statutorily required limits and Employers’ Liability of \$1,000,000.00.
