INVITATION TO BID

1.1 Competitive Cost Sealed Bids

The City of Perry is requesting qualified contractors to supply quotes for the removal of existing plant material, installation of new plant material, and installation of an irrigation system. A rendering of the design is provided for plant types and layout. The property is located at 808 Carroll Street, Perry, Ga 31069.

Sealed Bids for City Hall Landscaping will be received until 2:00 p.m. on May 10, 2024, at 1211 Washington Street, Perry, GA 31069. Bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud at said office. Any bid received after 2:00 pm on May 10, 2024, will not be considered by the Owner. Following the closing time for the receipt of bids, no bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days.

1.2 Scope of Work

The City of Perry is seeking a qualified contractor to supply quotes for the removal of existing plant material, installation of new plant material, and installation of an irrigation system. A rendering of the design is provided for plant types and layout. The property is located at 808 Carroll Street Perry, GA 31069. Quotes should include all labor and material cost for the following requirements:

- Water source is available on site. Contractor to be responsible for locating and installing connection and controller for irrigation system. Existing irrigation lines will be abandoned or removed.
- 2. Procure locally grown and sourced plant material from vendors in the central Georgia area as outlined in the planting plan. Planting sizes are listed below.
- 3. Provide a 1 year warranty on plant material and irrigation installation.

Trees

Japanese Maple – 7 gallon or B&B

Sweet Bay Magnolia – 7 gallon minimum or B&B 7' height

Shrubs

Camellia japonica – 3 gallon minimum

Anise – 3 gallon minimum

Dwarf Pittosporum – 1 gallon

Tea Olive – 3 gallon

Encore azalea – 1 gallon

Maiden grass – 1 gallon

Pink muhly – 1 gallon

Perennials/Bulbs

Cast Iron Plant – 1 gallon, 24-36" o.c.

Gaillardia blanket flower – 1 gallon, 18-24" o.c.


Bulb mix – 18-24" o.c.

Holly fern – 24" o.c.

Hosta - 28" o.c.

All work to be completed must be reviewed by City of Perry staff with all final decisions made by said staff.

1.3 Licenses and Permits

The vendor shall obtain and pay for any permits and licenses required for the performance of the work, post all notices required by law, and comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations bearing on the conduct of the work, as specified herein. For any work that requires an inspection certificate issued by local authorities or any other governing body, such inspection certificate(s) shall be obtained by and paid for by the vendor. The chosen vendor shall procure all required certificates of acceptance or completion issued by state, municipal, or other authorities, and must deliver these to the City.

1.4 Insurance

The vendor shall, at vendor expense, procure and maintain satisfactory public liability and casualty insurance to adequately protect the vendor's personnel and the City against damages for bodily injury, including death that may arise from operations under this contract, whether such operations are by the vendor or by the vendor's subcontractor, or anyone directly or indirectly employed by the vendor.

The City will require the vendor with which a contract is established to provide evidence of appropriate professional liability insurance, errors and omission insurance, and workers' compensation insurance coverage prior to commencement of work.

Such coverage must be provided by an insurance company or companies authorized to do business in the State of Georgia. Certificates must name the City as an Additional Insured, shall provide that contractor's policy is primary over any insurance carried by the City, and shall provide that the policy will not be cancelled or materially changed without 30 days prior notice in writing to the City. The successful vendor must agree, if awarded a contract as a result of its proposal, to indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims and losses accruing or resulting to persons engaged in the work contemplated by its proposal or to persons who may be injured or damaged by the firm or its agents in the performance of the work. Provider minimum insurance coverages are:

Workers' Compensation Insurance:

- State: \$100,000 or state required coverage, whichever is greater
- Federal: \$200,000 or federally required coverage, whichever is greater

Employer's Liability Insurance:

\$200,000 or the statutorily required coverage, whichever is greater

Comprehensive General Liability Insurance:

- Combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage: \$1,000,000 each occurrence; \$2,000.000 combined single limit.
- General aggregate- \$2,000,000
- Operations aggregate \$2,000,000

Personal Injury Insurance:

\$1,000,000 each occurrence

Excess/Umbrella Policy:

\$1,000,000 each occurrence; \$2,000,000 general aggregate

Comprehensive Automobile Liability Insurance:

- Bodily Injury: \$1,000,000 each person; \$1,000,000 each occurrence
- Property damage: \$100,000 each occurrence; combined single limit of \$200,000
- Combined single limit per accident for property damage and bodily injury-\$2,000,000

Prior to commencement of any work, these and other provisions will be established contractually.

1.5 Bidder Responsibility

Unless otherwise stipulated, vendor shall provide, and pay for, all materials, labor, tools, equipment, transportation, and other facilities necessary for the performance and completion of the work.

1.6 E-Verify Requirement

All bidders shall provide a signed E-Verify affidavit with bid. Bids will not be considered without the Contractor's affidavit. The successful bidder is responsible for obtaining a signed E-verify affidavit from their Subcontractors and Sub-subcontractors.

1.7 Rejection of Proposal:

The City reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive any informality in such proposals, to request new proposals, to revise the Bid prior to the time for final submission of written proposals, to proceed to do the work otherwise, to withdraw this Bid, to not award the contract, to not award a portion or portions of the contract, and/or to negotiate separately with any source whatsoever in any manner necessary to serve the best interest of the City. The City may not award a contract based solely on this request for proposals and will not pay for the information obtained and solicited. The information obtained will be used in determining the proposal that best meets the City's needs. Unauthorized conditions, limitations or provisions attached to a Proposal may render it as not complying with the City's original request and may be subsequently rejected. No oral proposal or modifications to submitted proposals will be accepted.

1.8 Amendments

The City reserves the right to amend this bid prior to the proposal due date. All amendments and additional information will be posted to the City of Perry website at http://www.perry-ga.gov/bids.php. The City will not be responsible for any oral or other unofficial interpretation of any element of this BID or its related documentation.

All bids must be received in the Department of Finance – Purchasing no later than 2:00 PM, May 10, 2024.
