

## Pre-Trial Traffic Intervention Program Terms and Conditions

Once you have been notified that your case has been accepted into the program, you must return all required documentation demonstrating you have successfully completed all of the program terms (including payment of total fees) to the Perry Municipal Court. You can scan the documents to <a href="mailto:court@perry-ga.gov">court@perry-ga.gov</a> or mail them to Perry Municipal Court, 808 Carroll Street, Perry, Georgia 31069 by the compliance date noted below.

Failure to comply with the program requirements by your compliance date may result in the removal of your case from the program; and you must appear before the court to handle your case. Once all requirements have been met your case will be dismissed and restricted. You will not be required to appear in court.

If you have not successfully completed the requirements outlined in your agreement by the compliance date, you must appear before a judge and prosecution of your case may resume. If at any time you are required to appear in court and you fail to do so, a failure to appear suspension and warrant may be issued by the judge and your drivers license may be subject to suspension by the Department of Driver Services.

To successfully complete this program, you must abide by **all** terms and conditions set out in this agreement by the compliance date indicated. Upon successful completion of this program your charges will be dismissed in lieu of prosecution.
