PROJECT: Pine Needle Park Playground

RFP 2023-03

As of October 19, 2022, the City received the following questions pertaining to RFP 2023-03:

1. Are We to remove any grass in the new playground area?

ANSWER:

- o If grass removal is necessary for the construction of the playground.
- 2. Are we installing any borders or mulch for the new playground area?

ANSWER:

- The new playground area must meet minimum ADA and CPSC regulations regarding acceptable surfacing and fall zones. It is within the designer's purview to propose suggestions for compliance.
- 3. Is the New playground area going to be at the same elevation level as the old playground?

ANSWER:

- Yes. This is not a playground replacement. This is a new installation adjacent to an existing play area with swings and a spinner. There should be adequate and compliant connections between the existing and proposed play areas.
- 4. Are we redesigning the old playground area in the shape of a circle as shown in the photo?

ANSWER:

- No. There is no redesign. This is an additional playground at an existing park and play area. The circle is showing relative location and size-it does not have to be a circle
- 5. Are we removing any mulch or borders from old playground to match the new playground area?

ANSWER:

- No. A small portion may need revision in order to create connections, but the existing playground is to remain.
- 6. In the park Trail, the trail loop was to be .25 miles long x 10 wide, are we to do 4 inches thick by deep?

ANSWER:

- This is a scope that has been awarded to another contractor. There is only playground connections in the scope of this bid.
- 7. What are the specs of the walkway to the .25-mile loop?



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ANSWER:

- o Not Applicable. The walkway is not within the scope of this RFP.
- 8. Is the trail level? Or are we to go with the flow of the Natural ground level?

ANSWER:

- o Not Applicable. The walkway is not within the scope of this RFP
- 9. Will the budget exceed \$50,000.00 or will that number remain?

ANSWER:

Budget is tentative and could change based on market conditions and other factors.
Budget, referred to as Total Price in the RFP, accounts for 30% of the evaluation criteria for this RFP. Proposals will loose points as their total proposed price exceeds the \$50,000 budget.
