

ADVERTISEMENT OF BIDS

Sealed Bids: Sealed bids for *Perry Worrall Community Center –Packaged AC Replacement* for the City of Perry will be received until 2:00 PM, July 30, _____, 2024, at the Perry Administration Building, 1211 Washington Street, Perry, Georgia 31069, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days.

E-Verify Requirement: All bidders shall provide their signed E-Verify affidavit with their bid. Bids will not be considered without the Contractor affidavit. The successful bidder is responsible for obtaining a signed E-verify affidavit from their Subcontractors and Sub-subcontractors.

Work to be Done: The work to be done shall consist of furnishing all labor, equipment and materials necessary to replace and install a packaged Air Conditioning Unit for the City of Perry for the Worrall Community Center as shown on the plans.

Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents: Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents are on file at the Perry Administration Building, Finance Department. Bonds: All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the bid amount. The successful bidder, if awarded the Contract, will be required to furnish a Performance Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount and a Payment Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount.

Madatory Prebid Meeting: A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 AM on July 16, 2024 at the Worrall Community Center, 1060 Keith Drive, Perry, GA. Failure to attend the mandatory prebid meeting could result in disqualification from the bid process.
